

2023-2024 AllPeopleBeHappy Fellows



The *AllPeopleBeHappy* foundation has awarded a Fellows grant to **Samaya Al-Eiadeh**, working with **Collateral Repair Project** in Amman, Jordan. Founded in 2006, Collateral Repair Project (CRP) runs various programs to serve children and youth refugees from Iraq, Syria, Somali, Sudan, and Yemen, ranging from education to trauma relief. It currently has two community centers in Hashemi Shamali and Downtown Amman. As a Program Officer for CRP, Samaya's duties are 1) support Arabic and Math youth tutoring programs, 2) support drop-in program, 3) train and coach new community volunteers, 4) implement and enforce child protection policies, and 5) monitor and evaluate program outcomes.



The *AllPeopleBeHappy* foundation has awarded a Fellows grant to **Amsalu Desie**, working with **Visions Global Empowerment** (VGE) in Hawassa, Ethiopia. Amsalu founded Visions Ethiopia, VGE's program in Ethiopia, and is currently its Executive Director. With the Fellows grant, Amsalu will continue in the role of Executive Director, but with the additional title of *AllPeopleBeHappy* Fellow. His duties include running and improving the services provided to 80 deaf children and young adults at the Visions Center for the Deaf in Hawassa and overseeing the 13 staff members and 6 community volunteers.
